# **INTRODUCTION**

Thank you for looking at this sample from 'OUR FIRST EASTER SHOW, an Easter performance suitable for ages 3-7.

**SYNOPSIS:** There are two completely different scripts included with this product. However, both scripts still link the same songs in similar ways:

**SIMPLE SCRIPT:** Recommended for very young children. This is a basic presentation of facts about various Easter traditions. As such there are no acting parts and everything is read by narrators.

**FULL SCRIPT:** This play features a rhyming script about a school of animals. Many of the animals have just woken from their winter hibernation, but before they can play, their teacher Mr. Owl wants to tell them all about the human traditions of Easter. Cue eggs, bunnies, hot cross buns, etc... Printable animal masks are included for every character, so there's no need to worry about having to sort out costumes.

**PARTS:** Very flexible! The full script has ten roles, which can easily be split, so that up to 60 children can have at least one line each. Plus, enough narrators' parts for up to 30 children.

**EDITABLE SCRIPTS:** Editable scripts are included to allow you to easily cut lines out or add your own extra lines and parts if required.

**TIMING:** If you stick exactly to the script, and sing all the songs, this performance should take about 15-20 minutes for the simple script, and 20-25 minutes for the full script. If this is too long, or too short for you, suggestions are included (as part of your purchase) which will help you cut or add to the production by 10-20 minutes either way.

NARRATOR: At Easter, we like eating chocolate Easter eggs.
