INTRODUCTION

Thank you for looking at this sample from 'OUR FIRST NATIVITY 2', a Christmas performance recommended for ages 2-5.

DISCLAIMER: Please note that for copy protection whole scripts are NOT included below, just the first page of each script. Similarly, only partial song lyrics have been included.

TWO SCRIPTS: Two editable scripts are included in your purchase. Both scripts tell the same story but in slightly different ways. The 'Play Script' includes acting / speaking parts for a number of children all presented in easy to learn rhyming couplets. The 'Simple Script' contains simple narrators' parts only, making this version of the script extremely easy to use, even for the youngest of children.

TIMING: If you stick exactly to the script, and sing all the songs, then the performance should take around 15-20 minutes depending on which script you use. However, you can easily shorten or lengthen the production by 5-10 minutes either way, using the provided editable versions of the scripts. Suggestions of ways to change the timing can be found in the detailed 'production notes' which are also included in your purchase.

CAST LIST:

<i>Part</i>	<i>Details</i>
Narrator/s	PLAY SCRIPT: In total there are around 30 narrators' lines in the play script arranged into about a dozen different passages. SIMPLE SCRIPT: The simple script has around 40 narrators' lines, but no other spoken parts.
Mary	Mary is on stage for all of the performance. She has 4 lines to say in the play script version.
Joseph	Joseph is on stage for nearly the whole performance. He has 6 lines to say in the play script version.
Donkey	A non-speaking part.
Angels	There are four angels with spoken lines in the play script version, but feel free to change this to have as many angels as you want, saying the lines altogether. One angel can sing song 2 as a solo if required.
Innkeeper	Has 2 lines to say in the play script version. Alternatively you could have the innkeeper and his wife with one line each!
Shepherds	Three shepherds have 4 lines each in the play script version.
Wise Men	Three wise men have 2 lines each in the play script version.
Optional Extras	The 'production notes', which you will receive with your purchase, contain ideas to include dozens of extra children.

NARRATORS: Thank you for coming today,
To watch our first nativity play,
We're only little, we're only young,
But we have lots of songs to be sung.

We've practised our parts, our costumes are on,
We hope you don't mind if we go a bit wrong,
Now it's time for our show,
Ready, steady, here we go!

SONG 1: **Clap, Dance, Shout HOO-RAY!**

Clap, dance, shout HOO-RAY!
It is nearly Christmas Day... etc...

NARRATORS: *(Enter Mary)* Once upon a time, many years ago,
There lived a girl called Mary, let's say hello.
One day an angel came to knock on her door,
The angel had great news in store. *(Enter angel 1)*

ANGEL 1: Knock, knock, knock.

MARY: Yes, who's there?

ANGEL 1: A little angel with news to share.
You will soon be filled with joy,
God is giving you a baby boy!

NARRATORS: Mary jumped up and down with glee,
She was feeling so happy!

SONG 2: **One Bright Halo**

One bright halo, *(Repeat)*
Two wide wings, *(Repeat)*... etc...

(Exit angel 1. Enter Joseph & donkey)

NARRATORS: Joseph came to say hello,
He would soon be married to Mary, you know.

MARY: An angel says I will have a son!

JOSEPH: Wow, a baby! That sounds like fun!

NARRATORS: Thank you for coming today,
To watch our first nativity play.

SONG 1: **Clap, Dance, Shout**

Clap, dance, shout HOO-RAY!
It is nearly Christmas Day... etc...

(Enter Mary)

NARRATORS: Once upon a time, many years ago,
There lived a girl called Mary, let's say hello.
One day an angel came to knock on her door,
The angel had great news in store. *(Enter angel 1)*

SONG 2: **One Bright Halo**

One bright halo, *(Repeat)*
Two wide wings, *(Repeat)*... etc...

(Exit angel. Enter Joseph & donkey)

NARRATORS: Joseph came to say hello,
He would soon be married to Mary, you know.
Mary and Joseph had to go on a journey,
They went to Bethlehem on a donkey.

(Mary, Joseph and donkey walk around the stage as if they are going on a journey)

SONG 3: **Wonky Donkey**

Wonky donkey riding along,
Wonky donkey singing this song... etc...

(Mary and Joseph sit by a manger. An angel enters and hands the baby to Mary)

NARRATORS: In Bethlehem, there was nowhere to stay,
Apart from a stable full of hay.
Jesus was born later that night,
Over the stable shone a star so bright.
(Mary places the baby in the manger)
They laid Jesus in a manger, he fell asleep,
Surrounded by cows, donkeys and sheep.
